Flint Bowmen Inc. was formed in the late 1930's by area archers and is one of the oldest archery clubs in Michigan. FBI has 30 beautiful acres dedicated solely to the sport of archery. We have four field tip courses and a broadhead course with a spacious practice range; and a large clubhouse with an indoor target range. Flint Bowmen is a family-oriented club, featuring leagues and shoots for all ages and abilities. Come out and enjoy archery with your family and friends.

How do I become a member?

To become a member of Flint Bowmen, Inc. you must be at least 18 years old. A membership includes immediate family members, and children based on legal guardianship. A packet containing the Constitution, By-Laws, Club Rules, Range Rules, Current Year Calendar, and Membership Card(s) will be mailed to the applicant upon receiving the dues and application form from the applicant.

How much does it cost?

Dues range from \$50 to \$130 based on the month a member joins and work hours performed in preceding years. Please see the Dues Chart inside this application. Seniors (62 years or older) receive an automatic 50% discount on all dues. All yearly memberships are due by January 31. Any membership that is delinquent 30 days after the due date shall be dropped from membership.

Club work hour requirements:

All active members age 18 years and older (adults) are asked to work a minimum of 20 hours (per membership) for the club. All work must be completed within the calendar year. A credit of \$4 per hour worked in the preceding year will be applied towards the current year's dues (for a maximum \$80 credit). \$50 in dues is the minimum required annually. A work hour summary for each membership is kept up to date by the Membership Coordinator. **Kids work hours do not apply to memberships but are tracked and recognized by the Club Vice President.*

How do you get work hours?

Club work hours shall be all work done by a member to help better the club. Examples include (but are not limited to): kitchen help, target setup, field judges, cleanup crews, workdays, registration, etc.

What do you get with a membership?

Memberships include: 24-hour access to Flint Bowmen; Discounts on Indoor / Outdoor Leagues three times a year; heated indoor range; outdoor range; access to many large shoots each year hosted by Flint Bowmen; playground area; and a wonderful place to shoot your bow, regardless of what type of bow you shoot or your skill level.

Meetings:

The Annual Meeting and election of officers is in January. Membership meetings are held throughout the year (see current year's calendar for dates).

Guests:

Members may bring out up to 6 guests at a time. Shooting Guests are charged a \$5 shooting fee for ages 13 and up, a \$2 fee for 12 and under. All Guests must fill out an insurance waiver.

All work hours must be worked and recorded before January 1st and are used to calculate your dues for the next year.

Starting with the 2nd year, a full 20 hours work will be required to receive the maximum discount on your 3rd year's dues.

You can receive a discount on your dues with recorded work hours. Each hour worked is worth \$4 per hour deducted from your dues bill. There is a minimum of \$50 yearly dues (\$25 for seniors, age 62+ as of January 1st each year).

***Dues are calculated based on previous year's work hours.**
