



Dan and Jacob Groth went to Louisville for the first time this year and had a great time. They are looking forward to doing it again in 2025!





Guest Shooters

When you bring a guest out to shoot at Flint Bowmen, please make sure they pay the guest fee. Just inside the front door is a box to put the money in. Adults \$5 and kids \$2. Everyone must also fill out a waiver PLEASE!

Are you a Senior? Are you paying senior rates?

Seniors age 62 and up, benefit from reduced dues at Flint Bowmen. Everything is cut in half! Your annual dues without any work hours are \$65; with your 20 work hours, your dues are \$25. If you are a senior, but you aren't getting a discount on your dues – then let me know. I won't ask anyone their age! To receive the senior discount on your dues, you have to be 62 as of December 31, 2024. This is not automatic – you have to let me know! If you already receive the senior discount on your dues, you don't have to do anything to continue receiving it. The senior discount is not retroactive, so be sure to tell me before the end of the year!


